
Testing Cell Monolayer Integrity on Corning[®] Transwell™ Permeable Supports



Introduction

Testing cell monolayer integrity on Transwell inserts is most often done by measuring transepithelial electrical resistance (TEER) across the cell monolayer or by measuring the amount of a nontransportable fluorescent compound, such as Lucifer Yellow, that leaks from the apical chamber between the cells down into the basolateral chamber.
